Enjoy Industrie 4.0 live

From 27.-29.11.2018, ITQ GmbH is presenting its new Smart Air Hockey Demonstrator at the SPS IPC Drives. The demonstrator has been realised in cooperation with AMK Group and offers visitors the chance to enjoy Industrie 4.0 live.

This year ITQ GmbH will be also present at the joint booth of Bayern Innovativ **(Hall 6, Booth 260)** at the **SPS IPC Drives fair (27.-29.11.2018).** The new Smart Airhockey Demonstrator will give visitors very close and live insights into how Industrie 4.0 and Artificial Intelligence feel like.

The joint <u>AMK</u> and ITQ project is an example for today's engineering and has been steadily developed in iterative steps by an international and interdisciplinary team of students in close collaboration with the University of Aalen within only six months. At the SPS IPC Drives two variants of the Smart Air Hockey Demonstrator will be presented: The "easy game variant" (ITQ) and the "big demonstrator" (AMK), which weighs up to 1,000 kg (1t). Visitors will find the latter one in **Hall 4, Booth 210**.

With the new demonstrator, a vivid trade fair demonstrator has been realised, presenting "Machine Learning" with a fun factor. Arcade atmosphere at the fair, realized by students with their own hands. The new Smart Air Hockey will demonstrate how IoT and automation related powertrain components are interlinked. The aim is to expand the range of IoT and automation-related demonstrators and thus to illustrate the already present ubiquity of IoT in everyday life.

Visitors can battle with the Smart Airhockey and try to putter the puck. With the help of camera systems, the movement distance of the puck is detected and the shuffle bat moves with the help of the drive motors lightning fast to defend its goal. Both variants prove that innovations can be realised in a very short time with the help of an agile engineering approach.
